A Sundance award winner and Oscar nominee, Johan Grimonprez's kinetic, urgent documentary delivers the politics of decolonization in jazz form, replete with virtuosic archival riffs, historical text in the form of Blue Note album covers, and musical performances by jazz legends (Louis Armstrong, Dizzy Gillespie, Nina Simone) who in the '60s doubled as cultural ambassadors to Africa.
